**Admission Notice**

Applications are invited for admission to the various Trades/Courses to be conducted in the various Govt. Polytechnics and ITIs of the State. The locations of the Polytechnic and ITIs where the Trades are to be taught are annexed here with.

The application Forms for admission shall be available in all the respective Polytechnics and ITIs of Jammu Division from 5<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 to 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 2016 as well as on the official website of the Directorate of Technical Education [www.jkdte.org](http://www.jkdte.org) and can be obtained free of cost. Detailed information can be had from the concerned Heads of Polytechnics and ITIs. The duration and the entry qualification for the courses are reflected in the Annexure.

The classes shall be started from 1<sup>st</sup> Week of March, 2016.

The following criteria shall be observed for making admission in the said courses.

- The candidate must be permanent resident of Jammu and Kashmir State.
- The minimum age of the candidate applying for admissions is 14 year. However, there is no upper age limit to apply for admission in any of the trades.
- The candidate must possess minimum Educational Qualification prescribed for the desired trade/courses.
- The selection shall be made on the basis of academic merit obtained by the applicants in their qualifying examination based on the minimum qualifications prescribed for the particular Trades.
- Preference shall be given to the women candidates.

**Salient Features:**

- The trainees shall be provided Financial Assistance up to Rs. 2000/- per month to meet their to and fro transport expenses etc. during the training course.
- The trainees shall be taken to different locations for on-the-job training. The cost of such visits shall be borne by the Department.
- After the successful completion of training courses, the trainees shall have to appear in the prescribed examination and the certificates shall be awarded by the State Council for Vocational Training (SCVT).
